In order for the virtuous cycle to take hold, trust must be created based on shared value, shared risk, a voice for each actor, and ownership of productive assets across the agricultural value chain







Honey	~ I50 (20%F)	500





Conservation Agreements




Farmers lose their contracts with GNP if they do not comply with the terms.

Currently:

- Output level
 - Daily data collection during technical assistance to SHF and beekeepers;
 - Weekly processed and sent to office;
 - Monthly departmental reports;
 - Quarterly institutional reports, partners and donors;

 - Bi-annual HH surveys: Baseline in 2017, follow-up in 2019-2020;

Improvement in progress:



Conservation enterprises approaches are defined by a development hypothesis (theory of change) that if income is increased through conservation enterprises, then participants will discontinue environmentally unsustainable activities, leading to reductions to threats to the environment.
