- Each group will have 5 minutes to reflect out loud on what they think “worked” in their proposed resolution and what they think could have done better. (No one else will speak)
- The rest of the class observers will then take 5 minutes to offer their views on what they thought worked well and what could have been strengthened (The group will not respond, only listen).
- Facilitators will share their views and answer questions from the entire class.
