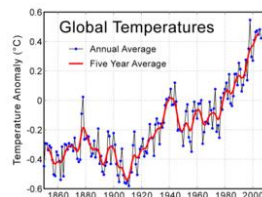

- melhorar a subsistência das comunidades locais que vivem dentro e no entorno das florestas.

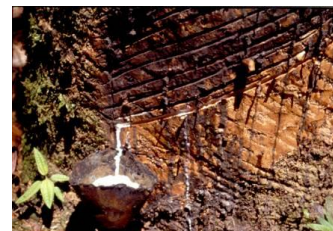

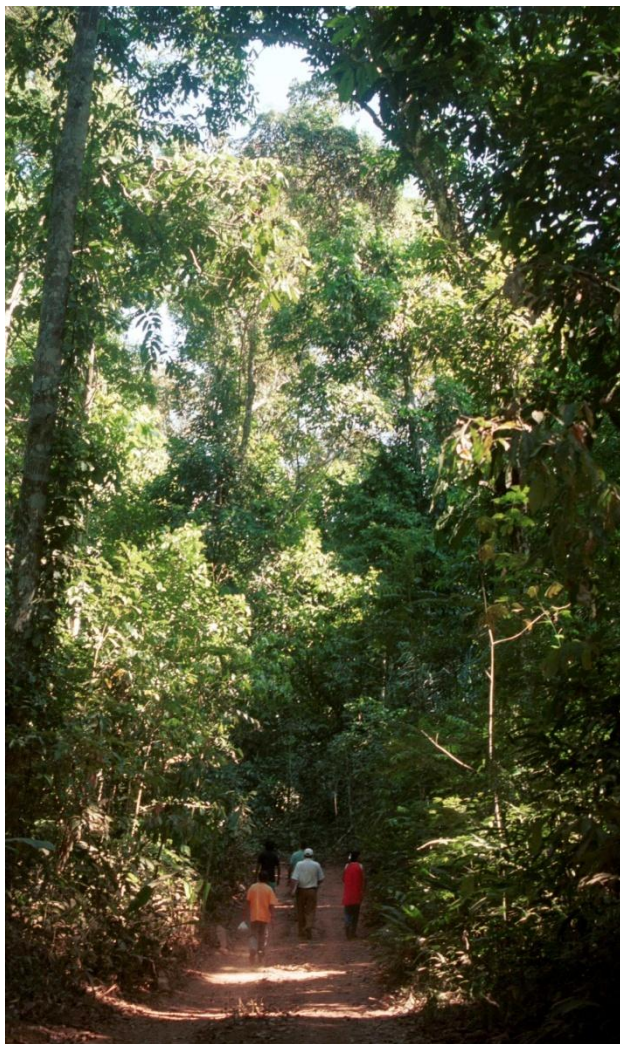
